Dr. Juan Francisco Pardo

Dr. Juan Francisco Pardo obtained his dental degree from Cayetano Heredia Peruvian University (UPCH) in Lima, Peru. He completed a fellowship in Periodontology at his alma mater. He was part of the AEGD program at the University of Connecticut where he did a residency and a fellowship. In the meantime, he obtained the license to practice dentistry in the state of Florida. Afterwards, Dr. Pardo attended the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB) and the VA Hospital in Birmingham, and was trained to do IV sedation; he also received his degree in Periodontology and a Masters in Science.

Dr. Pardo is a member of the American Academy of Periodontology and is actively involved in the APPO (Peruvian Association of Periodontology and Osseointegration) among other important dental associations. He is an active national and international speaker, lecturing in society meetings, webinars and workshops in different topics related to oral implantology and periodontics. He is also Colgate's national and international speaker for Latin America.

Nowadays, Dr. Pardo shares time between his private practice limited to periodontics and implant dentistry, as well as faculty member at the Periodontology postgraduate program at the School of Dentistry of the Peruvian University of Science (UPC).
