# SOFT TISSUE MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF DENTAL IMPLANTS

Dental implants are a rapidly expanding component of dental practice. Once placed, dental implants require ongoing maintenance to ensure health and longevity of these restorations. Poor oral hygiene can result in disease of the peri-implant tissues such as peri-mucositis and peri-implantitis.

Peri-implantitis is one of the leading causes of implant failure and long-term prevention is paramount. Dental professionals need to be able to identify potential problems early and know how to deal with them appropriately.

In most cases peri-implant disease can be avoided through proper oral hygiene instruction, the use of specific oral hygiene products and a well structured maintenance program. A significant void presently exists within the dental community on how to identify and manage basic problems associated with peri-implant tissues.

The course is designed to appeal to Dentists, Dental Hygienists, and Oral Health Therapists and will cover topics of interest to all dental professionals.
